





# CHALLENGE



## [INFRASTRUCTURE]



Jesus speaks these words to his followers, “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” Faith and money are like two sides of the same coin. Where the one is, the other is also. And it is easy for us to pretend otherwise, making faith immaterial or money unspiritual. However, how we handle money is a spiritual matter. Pastor Randy Alcorn says it this way, “It is impossible to become a fully devoted Christ-follower without becoming a fully devoted steward of the resources that God has entrusted to your care.” And for those who embrace His call of stewardship and generosity, God promises a life that is truly life. With that in mind, we believe that our best next step as God’s stewards in West Lafayette is to raise \$450,000 that will be used for the purpose of establishing a permanent location for our campus. By realizing this stewardship mandate we will be able to free up needed financial resources which will enable us to grow the ministry of our church, reaching more people in our community with the love and message of Jesus Christ.
